"Heritage Days - Fargo, ND"

A fun-filled rally is planned for you at Fargo, North Dakota. The rally site is conveniently located at Red River Valley Fairgrounds. Parking will be on Tuesday, August 28, 2018 from noon to 4 p.m. Rally registration will be from 1:00 to 4 p.m. A welcome dinner will be served to start off the rally, just before the Opening Ceremonies with the Installation of your Region 7 Officers.



On Wednesday, you will tour "Bonanzaville", a Pioneer Village with 12 acres, 43 historic buildings, 400,000 artifacts, and millions of memories. It is also home to the Cass County Historical Society and is the region's largest historical attraction with something for everyone to see. The museum features a display on Native Americans of the Red River Valley, bonanza farms and homesteading, and the modernization of North Dakota. Over the years, the pioneer village has grown to include the Eugene Dahl Car Museum, the Eagle Air Museum, the Tractor Museum, the Law Enforcement Museum, and more. Lunch will be served at the museum.



Thursday enjoy a breakfast prepared and served by the Minnesota Unit. At 10:00 a.m., the Region 7 business meeting will be held and **EVERYONE IS WELCOME TO ATTEND.**

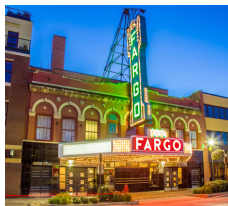
The afternoon will consist of seminars - Officer Training, SkyMed, and a Safety seminar.

Friday, you will visit the Western Minnesota Steam Threshers Reunion which started in 1940 with a little idea sparked from the soul of some



local Threshermen over supper. The Nelson boys fired up the old Garr-Scott engine to thresh with steam again for old time sake with family & friends. The event continued once a year until 1954, when the reunion met formally for the first time and invited the public. Today the show has grown to include hundreds of demonstrations and exhibits spread over 210 beautiful acres. The show attracts thousands of spectators and volunteers every Labor Day weekend. Some activities include Steam Power, Sawmills, Main Street, Horsepower & Farmstead, Blacksmiths & Foundry, Daily Parades, Music, and many more. The **Fargo Theatre** is an art deco movie theater in downtown Fargo. It was built in 1926 and was restored in 1999 to its historic appearance and now is a center for the arts in the Fargo-Moorhead area. The

building is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.



The **Fargo Air Museum** is an aviation related museum in Fargo. It is located at the Hector International

Airport in the northern part of the city. The museum includes many historic aircraft of which 90% are in flying conditions.

A 76-foot-long exact replica of a **Viking Dragon Ship**, built by some Minnesotan who just couldn't let go of a crazy idea, sits at the Heritage-Hjemkomst Interpretive Center, commonly known as the Hjemkomst Center in Moorhead, Minnesota.
